1           **WHEREAS**, on December 2, 2024, the Howard County Council unanimously approved  
2 Council Bill 61-2024 which provided for the creation of the Office of Inspector General and the  
3 Inspector General Advisory Board (the “Board”), and codified the Office and Advisory Board in  
4 Section 22.1200 and Section 22.1300 of the Howard County Code respectively; and

5  
6           **WHEREAS**, Section 22.1300(b) of the Howard County Code establishes the criteria for  
7 membership, appointment, and qualifications for the Inspector General Advisory Board; and

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9           **WHEREAS**, each member of the County Council shall nominate one member to the  
10 Board, the County Executive shall nominate one member, and one member shall be solicited  
11 through a public process and nominated to an at-large position by a majority of the County  
12 Council; and

13  
14           **WHEREAS**, the nominees have signed affidavits of affirmation to verify they are not  
15 disqualified from serving as outlined in paragraph (3) of Section 22.1300(b) of the Howard  
16 County Code; and

18           **WHEREAS**, the County Code calls for Board members to have five-year terms.  
19 However, the initial appointees to the Board shall serve staggered terms to ensure knowledge  
20 retention of the Board; thus, two appointees shall have a term of three years, two appointees shall  
21 have a term of four years, and three appointees shall have a term of five years; and

23           **WHEREAS**, the County Council has the utmost confidence and trust in the experience,  
24 abilities, and character of the nominees.

26           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the County Council of Howard County,

- 3 4. David Salem of Columbia, MD (District 4) - Term to end April 7, 2028.
- 4 5. Kathleen Downs of Glenelg, MD (District 5) - Term to end April 7, 2029.
- 5 6. Mitchell Stahm of Marriottsville, MD (County Executive Nominee)– Term to end April 7,
- 6 2028.
- 7 7. Katy Sedney of Clarksville, MD (At-Large Nominee) - Term to end April 7, 2029.
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
